Dear Parents/Guardians,

Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) is the State Department of Education's Monitoring and Evaluation System for public school districts. This comprehensive process, which occurs every three years, consolidates and incorporates the monitoring requirements of applicable State laws and programs and complements federally required improvements. The system focuses on monitoring and evaluating school districts in five components that, based on research, have been identified as key factors in effective school districts. The five areas are: Instruction and Program, Fiscal Management, Governance, Personnel, and Operations.

Because we continue to be designated a **HIGH PERFORMING DISTRICT** through the annual submission of the Statement of Assurance (SOA), we have been granted the opportunity to submit an Equivalency Application; we anticipate the State will approve our document. Thus, the District will not have to complete the QSAC District Performance Review (DPR), nor will we be required to undergo QSAC monitoring for the next three years. We will, however, submit the SOA each fall.

The successful education of our students remains our highest priority and is at the forefront of the Board of Education's Goals, in conjunction with those in our Five-Year Strategic Plan.
